



# Skidamarink Wheel

## Instructions

This craft can be used to practice times of day by having children turn the wheel and identifying the time.

This craft can take between 5 to 10 minutes to complete.

Young children may need supervision and assistance when using scissors and brads.

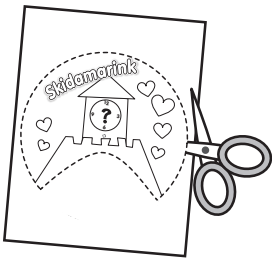
The times of day on page 2 come from the song “Skidamarink” on the *Super Simple Songs 3 CD*.

### What you need:

- Scissors
- A brad or pipecleaner for the center of the wheel
- Crayons or colored pencils (optional)

- Printout of Clock Tower Wheel (page 2)\*
- Printout of Times of Day Wheel (page 3)\*

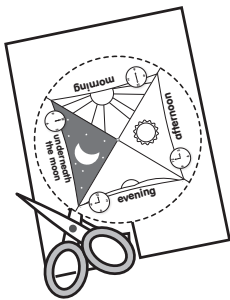
*\*Printing on card stock (thick paper) is recommended.*

### Step 1:

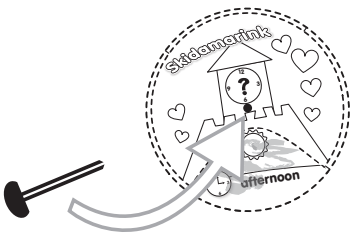
Cut out the Clock Tower Wheel (page 2).

Cut out the Times of Day Wheel (page 3).

### Step 3:

Poke a hole in the center of the wheels and attach them together with a brad (or pipecleaner).

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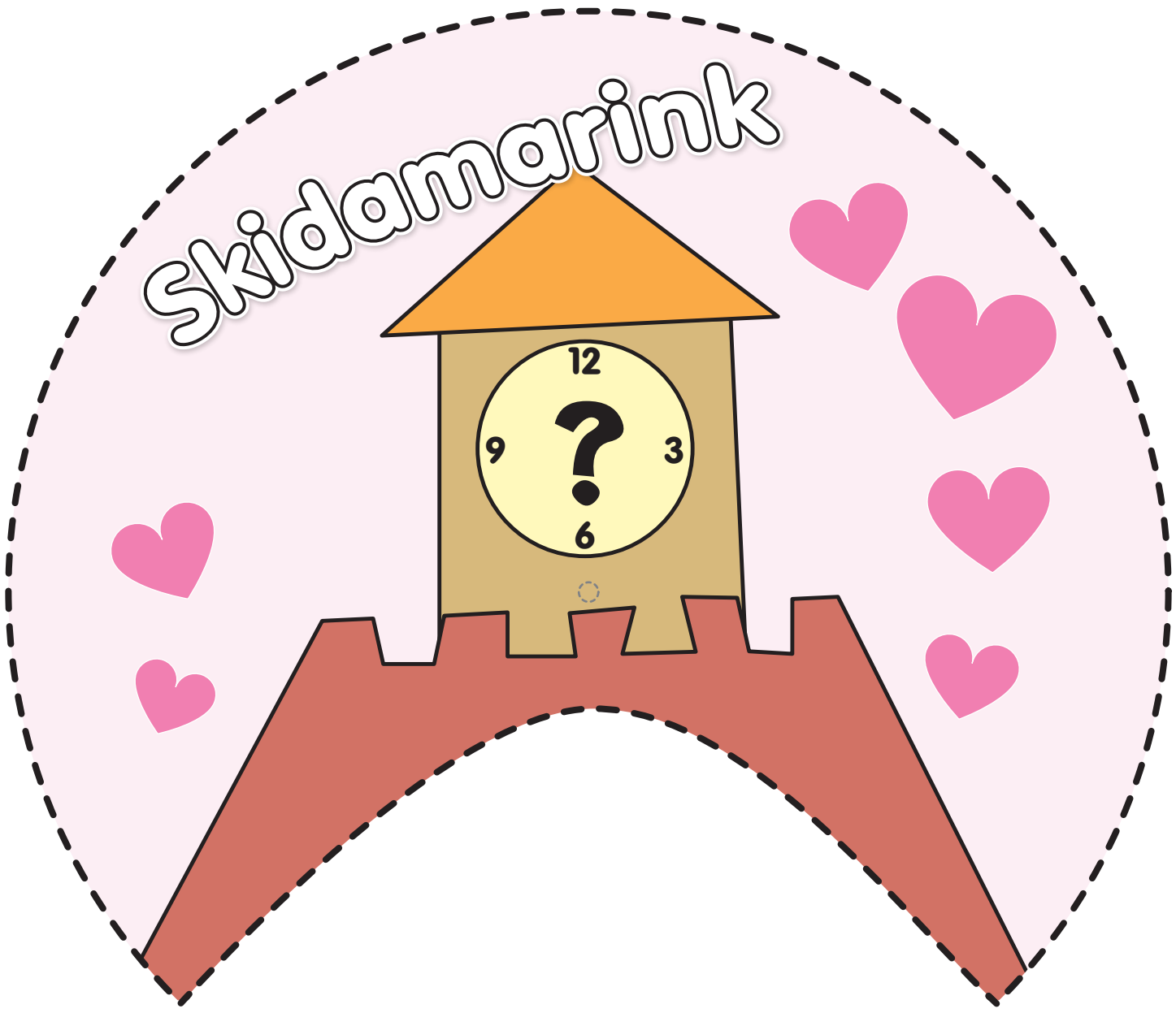
Sing along with “Skidamarink” as you find the times of day. Don’t forget to look at the clocks and tell the time. Skidamarink a doo, we love you!
